THE LOCAL STONE STORY

Saturday 7th October

2pm to 4pm in Chaldon Church

Peter Burgess, Mines Agent of the Wealden Cave and Mine Society will give an illustrated talk on:

- The ancient stone mines in East Surrey and their archaeology.
- The use of Reigate stone (from mines in Merstham, Chaldon, Gatton and Reigate) for nearly 2000 years.
- The potential value of the stone mines now as archaeological resources.

This is a joint event of the Friends of Chaldon Church and the Chaldon History Group.

Chaldon Church has significant use of the local stone within its structure, and in the font, the early Renaissance (Richardson) memorial tablet, and other features.

There will be a display of images as a mini audit of the use of the local stone within Chaldon village buildings - in walls, fireplaces, chimneys etc.

Admission £5 and no booking required. Teas and cakes will be on sale after the talk in the Hazell Room. Proceeds from the talk and teas go to the Friends for the preservation of the church building.

ORANGES & LEMONS CHURCHES WALK
Friday 20 October 2017

Cost £5 per person which will be donated to the Friends of Chaldon Church for the upkeep of the fabric of the church and the mural.

Starting at 11am from The Monument, in the City of London we will be visiting the six London Churches mentioned in the famous Oranges and Lemons rhyme.

We will visit them in this order:

St Clement, Eastcheap; St Martin Orgar; St Dunstan and All Saints, Stepney; St Leonard, Shoreditch; St Sepulchre without Newgate and finally St Mary Le Bow, Cheapside.

Some of the churches may not be open as they depend on volunteer guides.

We will be using public transport for some of the longer sections of this walk so bring a Travel Card, Freedom Card or Oyster Card. Actual walking distance is only four miles on pavements. Depending on the time we spend looking at the churches the walk should take about five hours.

For refreshments there are plenty of outlets or you can bring a picnic and, weather permitting, we will stop in one of the churchyards for a lunch break.
